Trip is part of a class that you are registered for.

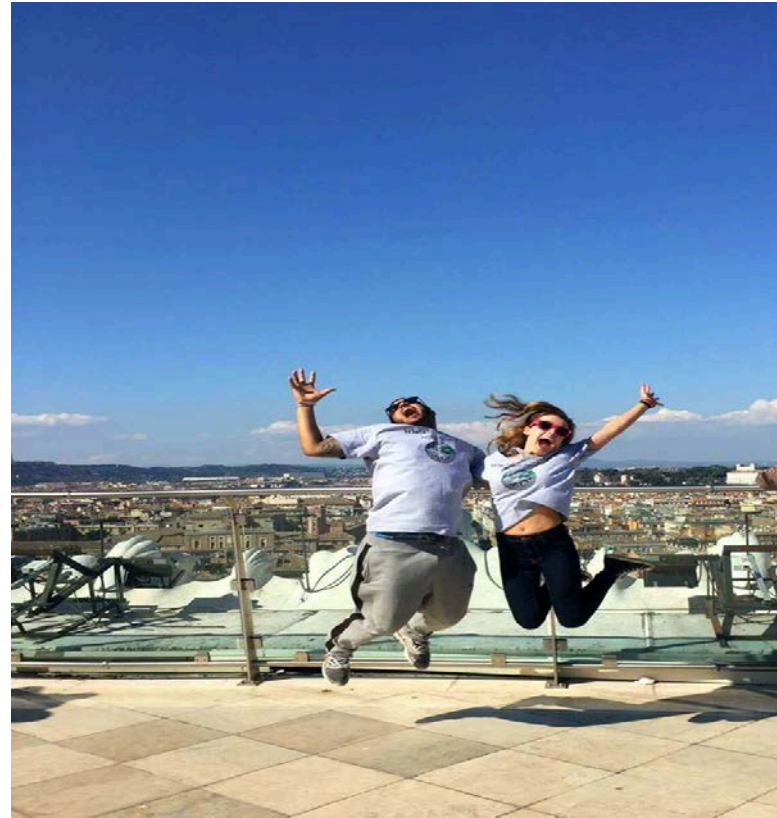
On a student organization trip:
